



## Homeland Security Technical Demonstration SDSU CITI: SDPD CIMU July 2-4 2005 San Diego

The Homeland Security Unit of San Diego State University's Center for Information Technology and Infrastructure will be conducting a technology demonstration for the San Diego Police Department's Critical Incident Management Unit during the weekend festivities for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.

This demonstration will involve the deployment of a number of wireless internet based cameras for the purpose of remote monitoring of known potential hotspots. It is anticipated that such camera monitoring will provide SDPD with enhanced situational awareness during the weekend celebrations.

The demonstration depends on community outreach by SDSU CITI staff and public goodwill to secure network access in those areas where no official resources are available.

Community participation is pivotal in the success of this demonstration, and previous demonstrations by SDSU CITI during San Diego Mardi Gras and SuperBowl showed that an overall high level of good will exists in the general community to provide assistance and resources to facilitate these technical demonstrations in support of law enforcement activities.
